LRCA membership begins at time of registration and extends through June 30, 2022. Membership includes:

- Eligibility to participate in LRCA leagues. Each seasonal league requires separate registration and fee. Members under age 18 require parental approval.
- Accident medical coverage (secondary) while participating in LRCA events
- Voting privileges for election of board of directors; eligibility to run for the board

Safety – All LRCA members are expected to conduct themselves so that they do not put other participants’ safety at risk. Signing of this application constitutes agreement to adhere to the Code of Conduct and the rules and regulations of the Lakes Region Curling Association. A member who repeatedly creates unsafe situations or exhibits behavior that is contrary to the LRCA’s Code of Conduct may be subject to disciplinary action. To foster personal safety, the LRCA recommends that all participants consider the use of protective headgear and gripping footwear during matches.

Concussion protocol – The risk of injury from falls while curling is real. LRCA members are expected to acquaint themselves with and understand the organization’s concussion protocol in order to identify and respond appropriately to the signs of concussion after a fall. Privacy – The Lakes Region Curling Association collects information by various methods, including information actively provided by its members. The types of personal information collected include: name, contact information, e-mail address, and photographs of LRCA league play, sponsored events, and learn-to-curl activities.
